

Trevian Spring Hockey 2008

Respond by March 1st!

With the winter hockey season beginning to wind down, it is time once again to start thinking about your on-ice plans for this spring. In its sixth season under the direction of Rob Malstrom (head coach of the New Trier White team), the Trevian spring league teams continue to gain interest from current and prospective high school players. Building on the success of last year's teams, we will continue to provide an opportunity for players to keep on the ice in a competitive and fun environment.

Due to the continued growing interest by players at all levels, **the program will first only be opened up to ALL non-seniors who currently skate in the New Trier program.** Incoming freshmen and other selected players will then be invited to fill any remaining open roster spots. The number of players interested and league registration rules will determine the number of teams that can be formed this spring and Coach Malstrom will decide the appropriate level of play. There is no guarantee that there will be a spot for every interested player, or that the player will make the team he desires. Every attempt will be made to place players on the team best suited to their abilities and other New Trier coaches will be consulted, as needed, in order to so. **The teams will be tiered by ability this year, so not every player will be playing at the same level.**

Most players have other commitments during the spring season and it is understood that your spring sport and academics come first. It is assumed that you will be participating in Coach Bob Melton's spring clinics in order to maintain your skating ability. No guarantee can be made that conflicts will not occur, but an attempt will be made to minimize them. Each spring team will roster 18 skaters and 2 goalies in order to field a competitive team when conflicts occur.

Each of the Trevian teams will be playing in the Illinois Spring Hockey League administered through the Skokie Park District. The season will run from March 29th to June 8th and will include 8 regular season games, plus 3 guaranteed playoff games. There will be no games during the Easter and Memorial Day weekends. In addition, each team will have a limited number of practices (2 – 4).

The anticipated total cost per player is between \$400 and \$500. The fee includes league registration (including USA Hockey registration for the team), coaching, games, and practice ice time. New players, or players who have misplaced their jersey from last year, will be charged an additional fee for a new jersey.
